The office of Rutgers WPF is situated in a street close to the centre of Utrecht at a fifteen minutes' walk from Utrecht Central Station.

By Public Transport

Departing from Amsterdam Airport (Schiphol) or Amsterdam Central Station

At the airport you go to ground level by escalator, to the platform at which trains leave for Utrecht, 's Hertogenbosch, Eindhoven, Maastricht or Arnhem/Nijmegen. It will take about 40 minutes to get to Utrecht Central Station.

If you are at Amsterdam Central Station trains regularly leave every quarter of an hour in the direction of Utrecht, 's Hertogenbosch, Eindhoven, Maastricht or Arnhem/Nijmegen. It will take about half an hour to get to Utrecht Central Station.

Arriving at Utrecht Central Station

Arriving at the platform of the station you go to the first floor (= central hall) by escalator or stairs and head for the Centre of Utrecht, passing a bookshop on your left hand and a take away on your right.

- By taxi. In order to reach the taxi-rank on ground level you walk straight on, take the windowed passageway on your right, go down the stairs and walk straight on until you are at the taxi-rank.
- By bus. Leave by the next entrance to your left, go down the stairs and take bus 1, 6 or 7 directions *Overvecht* or *Zuilen* (Ask the driver, since one has to choose between busses with the same number, going in different directions!). The bus stop, called 'Oudenoord', is at a five minutes' drive from our office opposite the Rutgers WPF office.
- On foot. Walk to Oudenoord, departing from the bus station (ground level), turn to your left, pass the level crossing of the tram on your right, walk straight on (passing traffic lights, a fly-over and the building site of our new music theatre on the right). There is only a pavement on the left now. At the next traffic lights (Apollo hotel on the right hand corner) turn to the left and walk for about 700 yards (passing traffic lights and a bridge over a canal) till you come to Oudenoord. The office of Rutgers WPF is on your left.

By car

The office of Rutgers WPF has only a limited number of free parking spaces at its disposal for staff and guests. Pay & Display parking space is available at the front of the building or you can park your car in Parking Garage La Vie in Sint Jacobsstraat, near the Apollo Hotel. We kindly request you to travel by public transport to our office if possible.
